## SHOW OFFICE & ENTRIES:

- Entry Closing Date: April 30, 2026.** In order to avoid being charged a late entry fee, the following **MUST** be received by the Show Secretary prior to this closing date:
  - All stabling fees;
  - All paid-warm-up fees;
  - Camping reservation fees; and
  - A completed entry form with at least **ONE** class entered plus the fees for at least one classOnline Entry Form Link: <https://www.cognitofrms.com/BCReiningShows/Rockslide2026StablingRegistration>
- Complete forms for your stall reservation, paid warm-ups, camping and the entry fees for a minimum one class – scan and submit to [bcreiningshows2022@gmail.com](mailto:bcreiningshows2022@gmail.com) OR via the **ONLINE REGISTRATION FORM** by this closing date to avoid a late entry fee being assessed.
- Scanned copies of competition license, registration/proof of ownership and **ALL** membership cards **MUST** accompany your entry. If ALL required forms are NOT submitted with your entry form, there will be an additional \$25.00 “surcharge” added to your entry (this in accordance with new NRHA policy)
- Please note that your entry is considered **INCOMPLETE** until you have submitted ALL required paperwork for both **riders and owners** – 2026 NRHA membership cards, horses’ competition license (if entering NRHA classes), proof of HCBC 2026 insurance (or equivalent insurance for other provinces) and proof of ownership (copy of registration papers)
- Note: HCBC membership proof is required for the horse **owner** as well as the **rider/competitor**.
- E-transfer payment for entries, stabling, warmups and camping to: [bcreiningshows2022@gmail.com](mailto:bcreiningshows2022@gmail.com)
- If you choose to submit your entries by mail, cheques or money orders should be payable to: **“Peninsula Reining Club –Rockslide”**. Your postal entry must include **ALL** the documentation noted above (membership cards, registration papers, competition licenses, entry and stabling forms) and must be received by **April 30, 2026**. Send to: Kathie Mackenzie, Site 3 Comp 5 RR 1 Carstairs AB T0M 0N0; and consider “mailing time” if you choose this option!
- NO post dated cheques! There will be a \$50 charge for all “NSF” cheques!
- Class draws will occur no earlier than 5:00 pm on the day before the class (eg: Thursday 5:00 pm for the next-day classes on Friday .... And so on ....)
- DAILY DRAW SHEETS WILL BE POSTED AT THE IN-GATE. Any changes made to the next day’s classes **before** the draw is made, will be without penalty.
- Once a class is drawn and posted, a POST ENTRY FEE OF \$60 WILL APPLY – post entries will be accepted until two hours prior to the start of the class (timing determined at Show Management’s discretion). Post entries will be placed at the beginning of the draw on Friday and Saturday, and at the end of the draw on Sunday.
- There are absolutely **NO** POST ENTRIES taken for class #35 (Bit & Bridle), class #37 (Non-Pro Buckle) , class #36 (Open Buckle), class #38 (Non Pro Ranch Riding Buckle), or class #39 (Open Ranch Riding Buckle) – these three classes **MUST** be entered before 9AM on FRIDAY (ie: before the start of the first class of the show)
- The Show will retain 50% of entry fees on all jackpot and money-added classes.
- Show Management reserves the right to cancel, transfer, or reschedule the show and/or classes without notice or liability. In the event of cancellation of the show and/or classes, all entry fees will be refunded.
- Inhumane treatment of horses will be grounds for disqualification, as will abusive treatment of officials and fellow competitors.
- All Youth competitors must wear approved riding helmets in competition and in warm-up arenas. Our Insurance prohibits anyone under the age of 18 years from handling, warming-up or showing stallions on the show grounds.

### NRHA CLASSES:

- All NRHA classes will follow the current NRHA Handbook. For copies of these rules, visit [www.NRHA.com](http://www.NRHA.com)
- Patterns will be posted before the classes and are also listed in the class list.

### WCRA CLASSES:

- All WCRA classes will follow the current WCRA Rule Book (2026 revisions). Eligibility and Class Descriptions of all WCRA classes are included in this entry package and will also available at [www.WCRA.com](http://www.WCRA.com)
- WCRA membership is NOT required to show in any WCRA classes. But WCRA membership **IS** required when riding for WCRA year-end Hi-Point Awards.
- WCRA Patterns will be posted before the classes, are shown on the class list, and can be requested from the Show Committee prior to the show.

## CLASS CONDITIONS & ELIGIBILITY

All WCRA “Beginner” rider classes are aligned with the current NRHA descriptions and eligibility for “Entry Level Ride & Slide” and “Green” class conditions. Following are the WCRA 2026 Class Eligibility/Criteria for “Beginner” rider classes – written descriptions are followed by a “grid” to aid understanding:

**WCRA Ride & Slide 1:** may be ridden 1 or 2 handed in any legal NRHA headgear; modified pattern with no lead-changes; no ownership restriction but riders must be able to meet the Non-pro criteria as set out in the current NRHA handbook; riders cannot have won more than \$75 in any reining competition as of the start of the current year

**WCRA Ride & Slide 2:** may be ridden 1 or 2 handed in any legal NRHA headgear; modified pattern with no lead-changes; no ownership restriction but riders must be able to meet the Non-Pro criteria as set out in the current NRHA handbook; riders cannot have won more than \$150 in any reining competition as of the start of the current year

**WCRA Green Level 1:** may be ridden 1 or 2 handed in any legal NRHA headgear; to ride any NRHA pattern (#1 - #18 with the allowance for “simple or flying” lead-changes; no ownership requirement but riders must be able to meet the Non-Pro criteria as set out in the current NRHA handbook; riders cannot have won more than \$200 in any reining competition as of the start of the current year

**WCRA Green Level 2:** may be ridden 1 or 2 handed in any legal NRHA headgear; to ride any NRHA pattern (#1 - #18) with the allowance for “simple or flying” lead-changes; no ownership requirement but riders must be able to meet the Non-Pro criteria as set out in the current NRHA handbook; riders cannot have won more than \$350 in any reining competition as of the start of the current year

**WCRA Beginner Horse Open:** may be ridden 1 or 2 handed in any legal NRHA headgear; to ride a full NRHA pattern (#1 – #18); “simple” changes are NOT permitted; no ownership requirement; restricted to horses that, at the start of the current calendar year, have not won more than \$500 in NRHA earnings.

### Rules for all WCRA Youth Classes in all WCRA events:

- Helmets are required at all times (this includes warm-ups areas as well as the competition arena).
- No stallions, monorchid or cryptorchid horses, to be handled by anyone under 18 years of age during a WCRA event (this includes but is not limited to the warm-up areas, the competition area, the show grounds)
- All WCRA Youth classes can be run either 1 or 2 handed in any legal NRHA headgear
- No restrictions to ownership or to previous showing status Age groups will be split as follows:

### WCRA Youth 10 yrs & under , WCRA Youth 11 to 13 yrs, WCRA Youth 14 to 18 yrs.

**Please Note:** If the rider is still eligible to ride in **NRHA** Ride & Slide or Green classes, they are eligible to ride in the equivalent WCRA classes, until their lifetime earnings have reached the earnings cap for the class.

**PRC Open Freestyle:** Open to all riders. No ownership required. 1 or 2 handed. Minimum maneuvers required are: 2 spins Right; 2 spins Left; 1 large fast Right; 1 small slow Right; 1 large fast Left; 1 small slow Left; 1 sliding stop with rollback Right Lead; 1 sliding stop with rollback Left Lead; Back up at least 10 Feet. Allotted time allowance 5 minutes.

## **Non Pro Buckle Class - Class #37**

### **Sponsor : Peninsula Hay Sales**

Must meet all the NRHA Non-Pro criteria

This class must be ridden one-handed in any legal NRHA headgear

The score from this class (Class #37) will be added to the rider's BEST score

from any ONE of the following NRHA classes:

NRHA Ltd Non-Pro (Class #6)

NRHA Rookie (Class #17/18)

NRHA Non-Pro (Class #20)

NRHA Novice Horse Non-Pro (Class #29/30)

Note: IF a tie occurs in Class #37 there will be NO runoff as this score is added to the best score from one of the qualifying classes. However, in the case of an EVENT TIE, after totaling the eligible scores, the contestants will runoff using the pattern in Class #37. If, unfortunately there is still a tie after the run-off, this award must then be decided by a coin-toss.

## **Open Buckle Class - Class #36 - NRHA Rules Apply**

### **Sponsor : Karlena Farms**

This class must be ridden one-handed in any legal NRHA headgear

The score from this class (Class #36) will be added to the rider's BEST score from any ONE of the following NRHA classes:

NRHA Ltd Open (Class #3)

NRHA Open (Class #22)

NRHA Novice Horse Open (Class #33/34)

Note: IF a tie occurs in Class #36 there will be NO runoff as this score is added to the best score from one of the qualifying classes. However, in the case of an EVENT TIE, after totaling the eligible scores, the contestants will runoff using the pattern in Class #36. If, unfortunately there is still a tie after the run-off, this award must then be decided by a coin-toss.

## **Beginner Bit & Bridle Class – Class #35 –**

### **Sponsor: Weston Performance Horses**

Must meet all NRHA Non-Pro criteria (except ownership)

Option to ride either one or two-handed in any legal NRHA headgear

The score from this class (Class #35) will be added to the rider's BEST score from any ONE of the following WCRA classes:

WCRA "Ride & Slide Level 2" (Class #11) WCRA "Green Reiner Level 1" (Class #19) WCRA "Green Reiner Level 2" (Class #28)

Note: IF a tie occurs in Class #35 there will be NO runoff as this score is added to the best score from one of the qualifying classes. However, in the case of an EVENT TIE, after totaling the eligible scores, the contestants have the option to runoff using the pattern in Class #35, or to be named Co-Champions. If unfortunately, there is still a tie after any run-off, this award must then be decided by a coin-toss.

## **Non Pro All Breed Ranch Riding Buckle - Class #38**

### **Sponsor : KelTech Safety Services**

Must meet all AQHA Non-Pro/Amateur criteria

Option to ride either one or two-handed in any legal AQHA headgear

The score from this class (Class #38) will be added to the rider's BEST score from any ONE of the following Ranch classes:

Non Pro All Breed Ranch Riding (Class #9)

Non Pro All Breed Ranch Riding (Class #24)

Note: IF a tie occurs in Class #38 there will be NO runoff as this score is added to the best score from one of the qualifying classes. However, in the case of an EVENT TIE, after totaling the eligible scores, the contestants will runoff using the pattern in Class #38. If, unfortunately there is still a tie after the run-off, this award must then be decided by a coin-toss.

## **Open All Breed Ranch Riding Buckle - Class #39**

### **Sponsor : Roseanne Locke**

This class must be ridden one handed in any legal AQHA headgear

The score from this class (Class #39) will be added to the rider's BEST score from any ONE of the following Ranch classes:

Note: IF a tie occurs in Class #39 there will be NO runoff as this score is added to the best score from one of the qualifying classes. However, in the case of an EVENT TIE, after totaling the eligible scores, the contestants will runoff using the pattern in Class #39. If, unfortunately there is still a tie after the run-off, this award must then be decided by a coin-toss

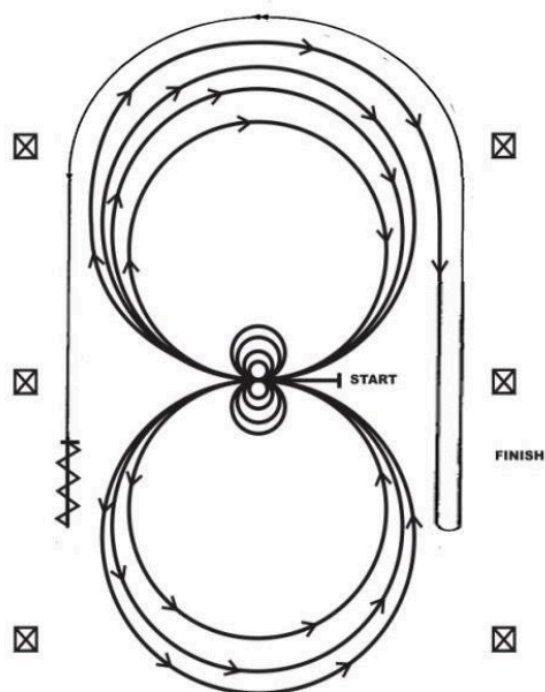

## Class #2 - WCRA Ride & Slide 1 (WCRA A)

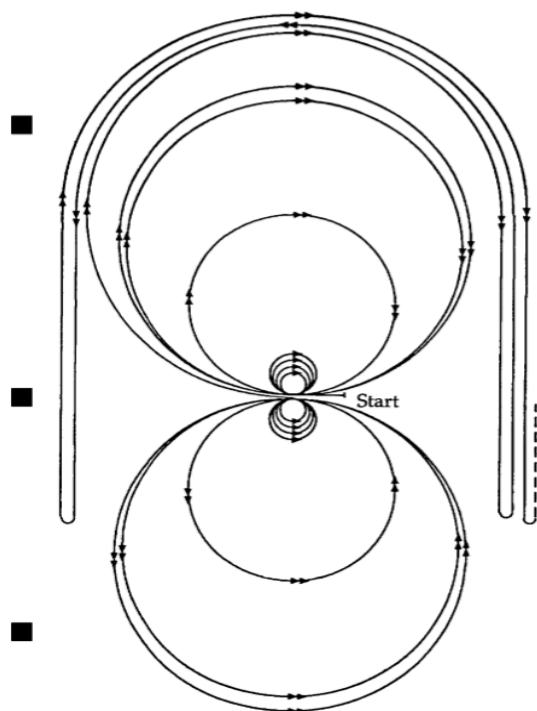
### **WCRA Beginner Pattern A**



1. Beginning at the center of the arena face the left wall or fence.
2. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
3. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: The first two large and fast, the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena.
4. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
5. Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: The first two large and fast, the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena.
6. Beginning on the right lead, begin a large circle to the right, do not close this circle, but run straight down the right side of the arena, staying at least 20 feet (6 metres) from the wall or fence, past the center marker and do a left roll back.
7. Continue around previous circle. Run down the right side of the arena, staying at least 20 feet from the wall or fence, past the center marker, stop and back up at least 10 feet. (3 metres)
8. **Rider must dismount and drop bridle to the designated judge.**

## Class #12 - WCRA Ride & Slide 2 (WCRA B)

### **WCRA Beginner Pattern B**



Beginning at the center of the arena face the left wall or fence.

1. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: The first two large and fast, the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena.
  2. Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: The first two large and fast, the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena.
  3. Complete four spins to the left.
  4. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
  5. Begin a large circle to the right, but do not close this circle, run down the right side of the arena, past the center marker, staying at least 20 feet from the wall or fence and do a left roll back.
  6. Continue around previous circle to the left. Run down the left side of the arena, past the center marker, staying at least 20 feet from the wall or fence, and do a right roll back.
  7. Continue around previous circle. Run down the right side of the arena, staying at least 20 feet from the wall or fence, past the center marker, stop and back up.
  8. Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.
- Rider must dismount and drop bridle to the designated judge.
